PPC Minutes

- Current business
 - Group picture – The group picture will be postponed
 - Disciple-makers Index
 - The survey has concluded, and a meeting was held on 5-14-17 to discuss the results. St. Charles Borromeo had excellent turnout. A website has been created to make the data available to a select audience for the time being.
 - We discussed an excerpt of the data results. Approximately 20% of our parishioners responded, which was greater than many of the other parishes. 97% of responders were “regular mass attendees,” and that they cover ~80% of the total stewardship offering. Approximately 2/3 of the responders were female.
 - Only about 20% of the responders have children in RF, meaning that we have a large percentage of parish members that send their children to RF but are not involved in the parish. We discussed ideas for reaching this portion of the parish, such as hosting events during RF for parents and handing out information pamphlets to cars in the pickup line
 - The Parish will be publishing information on our strengths, areas of growth in the coming weeks and will be forming an action group within the Parish to decide on actions moving forward. They will likely start meeting in June.
 - New PPC members
 - Father Jeff has 5 parishioners that have shown interest in joining the PPC. Chris had a couple that showed interest as well. However a maximum of 4 openings are available this year.
 - To help with the appointments, we decided to ask each appointee to provide a short response to the following questions - what is your vision of the pastoral council, and what would you bring to the council. We will review the submissions at the June meeting and make final selections.
 - Budget – Father Jeff presented the current 2017-2018 budget, as approved by the Finance Council
 - Personnel – Father Jeff discussed the opportunity to hire a full-time youth ministry and young adult minister. He’ll start June 1st.

- Parishioner Registration – The Parish will be sending a Parishioner registration form to help update our registry.
- The PPC will take July & August off and resume again in September. Steve will be transition to the role of PPC President as of June. The next meeting will be June 13th at 7 in the kitchen.
